

NOTICE TO ALL ALLEGHANY COUNTY TRANSFER FACILITY PATRONS

The following changes became effective July 1, 1998 with amendments on July 1, 2001, April 12, 2007 and July 1, 2007.

1. Vehicles with Virginia license plates will not be allowed to enter the transfer facility. Businesses with Virginia license plates who operate within Alleghany County are required to **first** register their business at the Alleghany County Finance Office, 348 South Main Street, Sparta, North Carolina. Those individuals with Virginia tags that own property in Alleghany County must **first** get a copy of their property identification card from the Alleghany County Tax Office, 348 South Main Street, Sparta, North Carolina. When presenting the tax card and driver's license to the transfer facility attendant, the name on the tax identification card must match the name on driver's license.
2. The Alleghany County Transfer Facility will charge all individuals for "non-household" waste. The charge will be \$52.50 per ton for household construction materials such as roofing shingles, siding, sheetrock, painted or treated wood products, etc. There will be no charge for the following exempted items:
 - a. white goods
 - b. clean wood, brush, lawn waste debris
 - c. scrap metal
 - d. demolition materials (concrete, block, rock)
 - e. scrap tires
 - f. fencing wire – must be clean of debris, rolled (not to exceed 4 feet in diameter) and tied with a metal tie.
 - g. recycling materials – cardboard, glass, aluminum, newspaper, magazines
 - h. general household refuse that is bagged

All "non-household" waste must be separated from exempted items. Any exempted items mixed with "non-household" waste shall be weighed and billed as "non-household" waste (no exceptions). All patrons who wish to dispose "non-household" waste must present their driver's license to the transfer facility attendant. Patrons who own property in Alleghany County will be billed on a quarterly basis. Patrons who do not own property in Alleghany County will be required to pay by check (no cash will be accepted) when disposing refuse.
