The Young/Beginning Producer Award is sponsored by the Alleghany Agriculture Advisory Board in cooperation with the Alleghany County, NC.

Purpose:

The purpose of the Young/Beginning Producer Award is to encourage young men and women who are in the beginning or developmental stages of their agricultural careers or endeavors. The goal is to provide recognition to those who are showing signs of growth and knowledge both professionally and personally in the field of agriculture.

Eligibility:

All applicants must be citizens of Alleghany County, NC or born in Alleghany County. Applicants must be between 18 and 40 years of age. Individuals may be part time or full time farmers/producers.

Awards:

The winner will be recognized and awarded \$1000.00 and a plaque.

The nominee or the sponsor of the nominee must submit the attached application outlining as completely as possible the work of the candidate and evidence of their effect on the agricultural life of the county. The statement should also cover the biography of the person including:

- Agricultural Activities (successes and accomplishments) (40 points)
- Obstacles overcome..... (15 points)
- Stewardship and Conservation Practices..... (15 points)
- Knowledge of Agriculture and Education..... (15 points)
- Community Leadership..... (10 points)
- Personality (include any additional information on biography) (5 points)

Nominations reviewed by the Awards Committee and not awarded this year, may be resubmitted next year by simply updating the original nomination. Additional support material may be submitted.
