



The Alleghany County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Friday, December 20th, 2019 at 2:00 pm in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 348 South Main Street, Sparta, North Carolina.

Present: Chair Bill Osborne, Commissioner Larry Prince, Commissioner Mark Evans, Commissioner Bobby Irwin, and Clerk to the Board Drew Temple.

Commissioner Larry Prince said it was brought to his attention that there is a Recreation Commission.

County Attorney, Donna Shumate said the Commissioners can dissolve the commission and that the Recreation Commission only has the power the Board of County Commissioners gives them.

Josh Greene said AJ Todd agreed to clear the poplar trees around the back, front and side of the Lion's Club Pavilion and remove the stumps.

Donna Shumate said the Alleghany Recreation Commission owns the property and reiterated that the County owns the property.

Commissioner Bobby Irwin asked for AJ Todd to look at the trees and lights at the Business Development Center.

Commissioner Mark Evans made a motion to allow AJ Todd to remove the trees and seed Lion's Club Pavilion pending a positive conversation with the Lion's Club. Commissioner Larry Prince seconded. Vote 4:0.

Commissioner Bobby Irwin said if the lease with Wilkes Community College was 20 or 30 years, the state would help with money to maintain the building.

Commissioner Bobby Irwin made a motion to accept the amended lease with Wilkes Community College. Commissioner Larry Prince seconded. Vote 4:0.
