



The Alleghany County Board of Commissioners met in special session on Monday, April 13th, 2020 at 2:00 pm in the Board Meeting Room of the County Administration Building, 348 South Main Street, Sparta, North Carolina.

Present: Chair Bill Osborne, Commissioner Bobby Irwin, Commissioner Larry Prince, Commissioner John Irwin, County Manager, Michael Carter and Clerk to the Board Drew Temple.

County Manager, Michael Carter explained the pattern of using fund balance appropriations to balance the county budget for the past few years.

County Manager, Michael Carter reviewed special appropriations pending for the rest of FY19/20.

Karen Evans, Finance Officer explained the procedure for reducing the appropriation to the Alleghany Co. Board of Education for FY19/20.

County Manager, Michael Carter went over the potential furlough savings and presented the scheduling changes for the Transfer Station.

There was discussion between the board and April Hamm, Finance Officer about utilizing SROs for other aspects in the county, haul and disposal costs and contract, Alleghany Health appropriation, Streetscape, tag office and LGC follow up.
