Dr. Beasley said he, Donna Rhea, Amy Bottomley and Sharon Lyons attended the grant award ceremony for the \$47M needs-based grant Alleghany County Schools received this year. He said there is a Form of Agreement needed for the project and read the document to the group. He said the new school is projected at 117,000 square feet. He said schools are being built for \$300-350/square foot. He said they hoped to send this project out for bid in January. He said some thought should be put into what happens if the cost is over \$47M? He said enrollment stays between 420-440 students. He said they are getting technical drawings together for the indoor batting facility and dressing rooms for the current Duncan Recreation site.

Heath Vogler discussed the health science, commercial kitchen, computer science and CNC ideas for the CTE program.

Dr. Beasley and Sid Carrier explained some needs for the auditorium building; steam-heat radiators are dangerous and hard to work on. Steve Carrier said it would be approximately \$300,000 to install a heat pump for heating and air conditioning in the auditorium. He said the building will need a new roof in the next five years.

Sid Carrier gave a facilities update.

It was a consensus to have these meetings quarterly.

Commissioner Mark Evans thanked Dr. Beasley and his team for pursuing this grant successfully and the Board and school team for taking good care of our students.
