Community Paramedic-Grant Funded Position

Alleghany County Emergency Medical Services is now taking applications for a full-time Community Paramedic. This position performs paramedic level life support, stabilization procedures, and emergency medical care. An employee in this position is exposed to the normal hazards of emergency rescue work, including risk of exposure to human body fluids and infectious diseases, thus the work is subject to the OSHA requirements for blood borne pathogens. Work is performed in accordance with established EMT and medical procedures and under departmental and local medical director approved protocols. Work is performed under the supervision of the Assistant EMS Director and is evaluated through peer review, conferences, observation, discussion of procedures at emergency scenes, and public feedback.

Graduation from high school, a valid driver's license, and successful completion of a paramedic program with certification as an EMT-Paramedic, including all required classroom and clinical training; or an equivalent combination of education, training, and experience that provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities. Completion of a Mobile Integrated Healthcare/Community Paramedic course from an accredited college is required within one year of hire, unless an equivalent qualification has been completed. The successful candidate must complete pre-employment drug testing, a criminal background check, and a DMV driving record check.

Starting salary is \$58,000. This position is grant funded and dependent upon continued funding availability. A successful 6-month probationary period must be completed before becoming a permanent employee with Alleghany County. Full-time benefits include county-provided health, basic vision, life insurance and long-term disability; holiday, sick, and vacation pay; and retirement participation in the NC Local Government Retirement System.
